Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Iowa County Health Department is working with your school district to provide influenza (flu) vaccine to your school this fall. Flu shots are available for school-age children 4 -18 years old. Funding for the school based flu clinic is provided by the Wisconsin Emergency Preparedness Program and the Wisconsin Immunization Program as part of a mass immunization exercise.

- Flu vaccine is <u>FREE</u> for all students, no insurance information is needed
- Flu vaccine will be injectable only

If you would like to have your child vaccinated at school, please do the following:

- 1. Read the Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) regarding the influenza (flu) vaccine
- Complete the Vaccine Administration Record Consent Form.
