Dear Dodgers:

We would like to invite you to join us on Monday, October 7, 2019, from 3:45 pm to 7:30 pm for 1st term Parent-Teacher Conferences. During conferences, we will also highlight timely topics and provide parents with resources so that they can assist their child in dealing with these important issues.

Parent- Teacher Conferences: Meet teachers and discuss your child's progress. This could be a discussion on areas for growth but it could also be to learn more about your child's strengths, compare notes on what you are seeing at home and what we are seeing at school, and discuss ways we can work together to assist your child in meeting all of his or her educational goals. Stop in the Main Office for a copy of your child's report card, assessment results, and a list of teacher locations. Drop in, no appointments are necessary! *Rooms vary based on your child's schedule.*

Advisory and Assessment Results: All DHS Students have an advisor that they are assigned to work with for the school year. The advisor serves as a resource and assists their students in navigating high school. This year, we have also assigned a second grade level advisor who meets with students on Fridays. Freshmen and Sophomores will work on Academic & Career Planning and a variety of current topics impacting high school students. Juniors will be focused on ACT Test Prep, and Seniors can obtain release or choose to study at school. After the ACT in March, Juniors will also be eligible for early release. On Friday, October 4, the advisory topic will be assessment results. Students will receive recent assessment results and watch a video on how to interpret these results. Parents will receive copies of Aspire and Forward results with progress reports. Consider asking your child to show you the assessment video and discuss the assessment results together.

Alcohol, Tobacco, & Other Drug Abuse Prevention and Intervention Resources: There has been a lot of information in the news about the dangers of vaping, opioid addictions, and heroin use. Useful parent resources can be picked up to aid in talking about these issues. *A table with resources will be located in the lobby near the A-wing entrance.*

On October 16th Dodgeville Students (grades 7th-12th) will engage in a conversation with Tony Hoffman about Mental Health, Substance Abuse and Addiction, Adversity, Choices, Attitude, Goals, and Bullying. Tony's work has overwhelmingly positive outcomes. He shares the motivation behind real life stories.
